Did You Know?

Did you know that your HUSD email belongs to HUSD and the public? There is NO expectation of privacy. Your district email should only be used for district business, and members need to be cautious of what they send.

Public records requests can be made on your emails. District email should only be used for district business, and emails should not be sent during instructional time.

Negotiations

The negotiation team has just finished restoration as per the agreement we signed last August 2012. As some of you are aware, the funding for schools has significantly changed in California. We are now under the new Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). This new funding will take 8 years to fully implement. In his new budget, the governor addressed class size for K-3. This will be one of the issues discussed in negotiations this year.
